*The Exam boards, the JCQ and the school strongly requests that students remain available until the 26th June and on the afternoons of In the event of an unforeseen disruption to the exam timetable and it being necessary to invoke contingency plans, these dates will be used.

#A small number of students may have an exam clash on these afternoon sessions (5th June & 11th June). A set procedure is in place to manage this and those students affected will have been informed about will happen.

You must be on time for all your exams. Arrive ten minutes before the start time.

Bring everything you need for the exam in a clear pencil case only. Water is allowed in a clear bottle with the <u>label cut off.</u> TKASA House bottles and sports bottles are not allowed. Sweets/other food are not allowed in exams (unless by prior arrangement due to medical conditions).

Bring everything you need with you - it is your responsibility to make sure you have the right equipmentthis includes calculators for exams where they are permitted.

Locations and seating plans will be confirmed a few days before the exams start and put on display at A block. Check in advance where you are sitting for each exam; do not leave it until the exam day itself as you may be in a different room to where you have previously sat for the mocks.

Exam dates and times are fixed by the Exam boards and the JCQ; there is no opportunity to 'catch up' or take the exam at an alternative time. You will be charged for Exams missed without medical evidence.

Mobile phones, watches and other devices MUST be handed in, not left in bags even if you think they are switched off. Failure to do so constitutes malpractice. See information for candidates document.

You may be in an examination room at the same time as Year 13 taking A Levels for some exams. On leaving the examination there is strictly no talking until you are outside and well away from the building.

Results will be available to students on Thursday 22nd August 2024. The school will be in touch with students about arrangements for collecting results nearer the time along with information on post-results services.
