***The Exam Boards, the JCQ and the school strongly requests that students remain available on the 26th June and on the afternoons of 6th and 13th June. In the event of an unforeseen disruption to the exam timetable and it being necessary to invoke contingency plans.**

Exam Timetable Clashes

Students who have a clash of subjects in the same session must take one of the papers in the preceding or following session on the same day and remain under centre supervision until both papers have been completed (*however AS and A Level Maths & Further Maths cannot be moved - they must always remain in the PM session*):

What is Centre Supervision?

A member of Centre staff or an Invigilator will always be in the same room as the candidate(s).

Candidate(s) may revise using their own resources whilst under Centre supervision between examinations but must not:

- a) Be in possession of an electronic communication/storage device or have access to the internet
- b) Have contact with any candidate who has sat the examination
- c) Be coached by a member of centre staff

(see JCQ Instructions for Conducting Examinations Section 7.5)

The Examination Officer will personally speak to candidates who have a clash to make the necessary timetable adjustments and explain the process to them.

Some points to Remember:

You must be on time for all your exams.

You are under exam conditions from the moment you enter the examination room, this means no talking. Candidates can be reported for malpractice to the Awarding Bodies for breaking this rule.

Bring everything you need for the exam in a clear pencil case only. Water is allowed in a clear bottle with the label cut off. Sweets/other food are not allowed in exams (unless for a medical reason and must be pre-arranged with the examination officer).

Do not pick up your pen until told to do so by the invigilator.

Locations and seating plans will be confirmed a few days before the exams start and put on display at the front of A block. Check in advance where you are sitting for each exam; do not leave it until the exam day itself.



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Exam dates and times are fixed by the Exam boards and the JCQ; there is no opportunity to 'catch up' or take the exam at an alternative time. If you miss an exam without medical evidence you will be charged for the Exam Fee.

Mobile phones and ALL types of watches and devices **MUST** be handed in, not left in bags even if switched off. Failure to do so constitutes malpractice. See information for candidates document.

Results will be available to students on Thursday 15th August 2024. The school will be in touch with students about arrangements for collecting results nearer the time and to let candidates know about post-results services.
