Business is a dynamic subject. Before you can make money in business you need to understand how business works! Even if you haven't previously studied business, as shoppers, savers, or workers you will already know a lot about how the economy works. In the news every day you hear about new products being launched, firms being taken-over, unemployment, inflation, interest rates, the exchange rate, the stock market, Brexit, the impact of Covid and a wide range of other topics.

The A level programme is assessed by three equally weighted exam papers at the end of Year 13 which each last 2 hours and cover the complete specification, testing students on a range of contemporary business issues that are relevant in today's society.

PROGRESSION

A business qualification is an excellent foundation for a wide range of careers. Many of our students go to university to study business, accountancy or economics before specialising in the following career areas:

- Accounting and finance
- Business management
- Retail and sales
- Marketing and advertising
- Human resources

Other students begin Higher Level apprenticeships after studying A level business.
