A LEVEL: DRAMA & THEATRE

(Awarding Body Pearson Edexel)



CONTENT

The Pearson Edexcel Level 3 Advanced GCE in Drama and Theatre consists of two non-examination assessment components and one externally examined paper.

Component 1 - Devising.

40% of the qualification - 80 marks

Content overview

As a group, students devise a piece of original theatre, using one key extract from a performance text and in the style of a key

theatre practitioner. Students may complete this component either as a performer or as a designer.

Assessment overview - Internally assessed and externally moderated.



Component 2 - Text in performance.

20% of the qualification - 60 marks

Content overview

Students produce two performances from two different plays. The first one as a group performance from a performance text. The second as a monologue or a duologue performance from a different performance text.

Assessment overview - Externally assessed by a visiting examiner.

Component 3: Theatre Makers in Practice.

40% of the qualification - 80 marks

Content overview

Students will sit a written exam. This is in three sections:

- Section A: Evaluating a live performance students will go to see
- Section B: A study of a play text.
- Section C:A study of a second play text.
