Pastoral structure 2019-2020

Dear Parent/Carer

As we rapidly reach the end of another school year, I am writing to inform you of some minor changes to tutor teams and Heads and Assistant Heads of Year from next academic year.

For the vast majority of students in school, they will continue with the same tutor and Head of Year they have had this year and will therefore move seamlessly into the new academic year. However, for some students they will return to school in September with a new tutor.

One reason for this change is due to normal staffing changes all schools experience each year. We will be having some staff leave us at the end of the year for teaching positions elsewhere and they will have been replaced by new colleagues starting at the school from September. The other reason may be that specific staff who were tutors last year may have changed their role in school through structural changes or promotion.

One of those changes is that Mrs Gibson has been appointed as the new Head of Year 8 from September, so will take over with that year group from Mr Harris who has been Head of Year 7 this year. Mr Harris will pick up the new Year 7 cohort joining us in September. The vacant Head of Year position became available due to Miss Charles, previously Head of Year 11, being promoted to a position on the school Leadership Team as Assistant Principal.

All students and staff are being informed of the changes this week in staff meetings, assemblies and tutor time.
