

Nature of God	Tawhid – One God. 99 names. Shi’a – God is always fair. <i>"There is no God but Allah".</i>	
Differences of Sunni & Shi’as	Caliph – Sunni = Abu Bakr, Shi’a = Ali. (<i>"And Ali is the friend of God"</i>) Sunni = Six Articles Shi’a = Five Roots & Ten Branches	
Angels	Created by God with no free will. Jibril – the messenger of the Holy books. Mika’il – rewards good deeds & provides nourishment (rain). Kiraman & Katibin – recording angels. Munkar & Nakir – interrogate when in the grave (barzakh). <i>"Each person has angels before him and behind"</i>	
Predestination	Sunni – Al Qadr – God’s plan can’t change. Shi’a – Ba’da – God’s plan can change – but Judgement day will happen. <i>"Only what God has decreed will happen to us".</i>	
Life after death	Akhirah (the afterlife). Human actions are recorded in the Book of Decrees. Once everyone is resurrected God will Send people to al-Jannah (heaven) or al-Jahannam (hell) on Judgement Day. Everyone crosses the sirat bridge before Going to heaven/hell. <i>"Garments of fire for those who Disbelieve"</i> & <i>"any fruit they choose; a reward for what they used to do"</i> .	
Prophets (Risalah)	Adam – 1 st prophet. Iblis (satan) disliked humans because Adam was more important to God so Iblis is the tempter of humans. <i>"He created man from clay"</i> . Ibrahim – God asked him to sacrifice his son, Ishmael, but God saved him. His dedication to God is celebrated in Eid-ul-Adha. Muhammad – <i>"The seal of prophets"</i> the final messenger to whom the Qur’an was revealed.	

Imams	<p>Sunni = Leader of a mosque. Shi'a = descendants of Ali. 12th Imam is hidden on Earth and will return on Judgement day with Jesus to fight the false prophet.</p>	
Holy Books (Kutub)	<p>Qur'an – infallible final message of God (revealed by Jibril on the night of Power). Hadith = Sayings of Muhammad Sunnah = Actions of Muhammad Torah (revealed to Moses), Psalms (revealed to David), Gospel (revealed to Jesus) & Scrolls of Abraham (to Abraham). <i>"There is no God but Allah".</i></p>	
5 Pillars;	<p>Shahadah – <i>"There is no God but Allah, Muhammad is his messenger"</i>. Salah – Prayer. 5 times a day facing the Ka'aba. Prostrating position (hands and knees). Recite rak'ah – sequences of prayer. Jummah prayer = Friday prayers. Sawm – Fasting during daylight hours to remember the less fortunate. Read the Qur'an and pray more during Ramadan. Zakah – 2.5% to charity. Sadaqah = extra money to charity. Khums = Shi'a tax 20% on luxury items. Hajj – Pilgrimage to Mecca. Circle the Ka'aba 7 times. Throw stones at Jamarat pillars to ward off the devil. Drink from the Zamzam well. <i>"Pilgrimage to the House is a duty owed to God"</i>.</p>
