CONTENT

This course will provide learners with the skills, knowledge and understanding to progress into higher education. It will be taken as part of a study programme alongside other qualifications or A levels such as biology and physics. The course will also enable students to be ready for the sector, going into work on completion.

The mandatory units will give learners an understanding in wider contexts of different environments and settings where care can take place, the importance of effective communication, the importance of legislation and how to deliver a person-centred approach. The development of transferable skills such as communication, research, planning and organisation is also seen throughout the course content.

The course Year 12 will see the students complete two external exams as well as an internal assessment to be moderated by OCR. In year 13 the students will complete a further external exam and two internal assessments moderated by OCR.

Unit 24: Public health - internal assessment (year 13)

The mixture of units provided for the students will encourage them to build skills that will enable them to thrive in the Health and Social Care sector. Building confidence, skills and understanding of many aspects of the sector and beyond.
